FEATURE ARTIST

Wood Carving Artist Darren Jones will be the feature artist for the weekend. He will be performing demonstrations working on various art pieces. The collection of 12 trees that he has carved in the park will be dedicated to the Town and the Historical Society on this weekend.

Advertising and coverage will be pursued through Arts and Culture sections of various newspapers, TV and radio stations prior to the weekend event. The Darren Jones collection will become a feature attraction at the park. The events committee will be placing advertisements in strategic area tourists publications, as well as have flyers sent out to art and frame stores throughout the province.

On this weekend in Rimbey, there will be in excess of 4,000 tourists in town for a multitude of events.

”Art in the Park” This 2 day event will present artists with an amazing venue to display their art.

1. There will not be a juried process, all comers are welcome. Depending on response participation may be limited, so make sure you can obtain a spot register NOW.
2. There is no Registration fee.
3. The artists will agree to pay a 15% commission on all sales generated over the 2 day event. Proceeds will go to the Pas-Ka-Poo Park Historical Society.
4. All participants are encouraged to bring their own 10x10 tents, and they will be strategically placed in the park.
5. Artists may also rent a table from the Farmers market \$12.00 per day. To reserve a table call Market manager Gail at 403-843-6864

6. If artists have their own tables and chairs, there isn't a charge for placing them on the ground, but they will be supervised in the placement by the event coordinator.

There will be security on the ground overnight on the Saturday night, as well as art displays may be locked down in various museum buildings.
